The School reserves the right to terminate the student or withhold the certificate for insufficient academic progress, non-payment of academic costs, or failure to comply with rules and policies established by the School as outlined in the catalog and this agreement.

Although placement assistance can be offered if requested by the Student, the School does not guarantee employment.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

This document and the catalog constitute a binding contract between the School and the Student and no further modification or representation except as herein expressed by both parties will be recognized.

CREDENTIAL AWARDED

Upon satisfactory completion of the program and when all monetary obligations are fulfilled to the School, the Student will be awarded an IDC Certificate of Completion. This Certificate of Completion qualifies the Student to attend an Instructor Exam.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

Should a Student's enrollment be terminated or cancelled for any reason, all refunds will be made according to the following refund schedule:

1. Cancellation can be made in person, by electronic mail, by Certified Mail or by termination.
 2. All monies will be refunded if the School does not accept the applicant or if the Student cancels within three (3) business days after signing the enrollment agreement and making initial payment.
 3. Cancellation after the third (3rd) Business Day, but before the first class, will result in a refund of all monies paid, with the exception of the registration fee (not to exceed \$320.00).
 4. Cancellation after attendance has begun, but prior to 40% completion of the program, will result in a Pro Rata refund computed on the number of hours completed to the total program hours.
 5. Cancellation after completing 40% of the program will result in no refund.
 6. Termination Date: When calculating the refund due to the Student, the last date of actual attendance by the Student is used in the calculation unless earlier written notice was received.
 7. Refunds will be made within 30 days of termination of the Student's enrollment or receipt of a Cancellation Notice from the Student.
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
