



2017 Snorkel Camp

This summer, let your kids explore the amazing ocean world that thrives just below the water's surface! Pura Vida Divers' Snorkel Camp will help kids ages 6 - 10 perfect their snorkeling skills and encourage them to discover local underwater animals and habitats.

Whether your child is a beginning swimmer or already comfortable snorkeling, our experienced counselors will work with them to perfect their techniques, using exciting games and group activities. We will teach them how to identify local wildlife, and why it's important to respect our surroundings to ensure that nature continues to thrive.

Each Snorkel Camp session is 1 week long, and camp runs daily from 9 am - 2 pm. The camp will culminate in a fun family pizza party, followed by a snorkel session on Friday afternoon at Phil Foster Park, just a few minutes down the road from our shop. Campers and their parents will join us to explore the Snorkel Trail, packed with vibrantly colored tropical fish, bright pink sponges, lobster and more!

Each camper is required to bring a well-fitting set of Mask, Snorkel and Fins, as well as a pair of water shoes. Discounted Snorkel Packages are available to campers at Pura Vida Divers, and must be acquired before camp begins.

Each day, campers should arrive with a positive attitude, and bring along a healthy lunch, refillable water bottle, sunscreen, swimsuit, towel, hat and change of dry clothes.

Snorkel Camp is \$199 per camper and includes a custom rash guard (swim shirt), all pool and swimming fees, games and activities, and an end-of-camp pizza party.

Parents and campers, please read the Camp Rules outlined below and sign the bottom of this form to indicate your understanding of these rules and your commitment to adhering to them.

1. Follow directions given by camp counselors, camp volunteers, and lifeguards.
2. Respect your fellow campers, camp counselors, volunteers, and other swimmers.
 - a. Listen quietly and follow instructions the first time they are given.
 - b. Speak politely to others.
 - c. Stay in your designated swim area.
3. Participate in games and activities with a positive attitude.
4. Keep hands and feet to yourself.
5. Respect nature and your surroundings
 - a. Do not litter. Throw away all trash after lunch. Bring home everything you brought with you to camp each day.
 - b. Do not touch wildlife.
6. Bullying in any manner will not be tolerated.

Failure to adhere to any of the above rules may lead to the following disciplinary actions:

1. Verbal warning
2. Placement in Time-Out, followed by a discussion about the camper's behavior and future consequences of inappropriate behavior.
3. Exclusion of camper from a specific activity.
4. Expulsion of the camper from Snorkel Camp.

Camper participation in all activities remains solely at the discretion of Pura Vida Divers staff. No refunds will be issued for campers' exclusion from activities or expulsion from the Snorkel Camp.

We have reviewed the Camp Rules and understand them. We agree to follow all camp rules and will respect the judgement of camp counselors and Pura Vida staff in the event that disciplinary actions are needed.

First Aid & Medications

Counselors trained and certified in First Aid/CPR will be with the camp group at all times, as well as fully supplied first aid kits. Pura Vida Divers staff are NOT certified lifeguards; however, all in-water Snorkel Camp activities will take place at lifeguard-supervised locations.

The scope and authority of our immediate camp staff is limited to basic lifesaving practices, first-aid and CPR, any incidents beyond that scope will be referred to emergency medical services. For all injuries/illness incurred at camp, that Pura Vida Divers Camp Staff is made aware of, including minor injuries/illnesses, a camper's parent/guardian will be notified of that injury/illness. Depending on the severity of the incident, the camper's parent or guardian may be called, while minor scrapes and injuries may be communicated at the time of camper pick up. Any incidents requiring emergency services be called to respond, the parent/guardian will be contacted as rapidly as possible.

It is the policy of Pura Vida Divers that our camp staff **WILL NOT ADMINISTER** prescription medications to camp participants (campers). Over-the-counter medications, unless a specific need arises while performing first-aid, will also not be administered by Pura Vida Divers staff. If a camper(s) requires medication, it is recommended that medication be administered by their parent or legal guardian prior to the beginning of camp and/or after the camp program has ended.

TERMS OF SERVICE & REFUND POLICY:

If Pura Vida Divers cancels a day or week of camp due to dangerous weather conditions, or other conditions beyond its control, you will receive 100% credit towards another camp day or camp week. Any portion of less than one camp session is not refundable if weather causes early cancellation of camp.

A full 100% refund can be offered to any family **60 days** prior to your child's week of camp.

75% of your registration payment can be refunded to any family **30 days** prior to your child's week of camp.

50% of your registration payment can be refunded to any family **two weeks** prior to your child's week of camp only if the vacant spot can be filled.

All refund request **less than two weeks** of your child's camp will not be honored except for medical or family emergencies.

Refund request due to family emergency or illness will be handled on a case by case basis. Medical refunds must be accompanied by supporting medical documentation.

No refunds will be made for individual days of camp.

All requests must be made in writing and must arrive no later than the first day of camp. You will forfeit your right to a refund if your child does not show on the first day of camp, and you have not called prior.
